

On the 20th April 2013 Barnet Football Club played their last ever match at Underhill Stadium.

Forced to move by an unsympathetic council, the club and it's fans had to come to terms with losing what had been the focal point of their community for 106 years. The timing couldn't have been worse. The club were having a disastrous season on the pitch and would also face relegation from the league unless they won their final few games. Picking up the story six weeks prior to the end of the season, Underhill uses candid and often humorous interviews with fans and personalities associated with the club to document the end of an era for this modest, unglamorous but fiercely supported North London football club.
